Mr. Antonio Guterres, Secretary General of the United Nations, we send this petition to you, with a copy to the authorities that govern the nations of this earth, and to its citizens, since we are all part of every decision that may be taken in each territory in which we live, for the sole reason of protecting the welfare of human life.

For this reason, with the power exercised by the UN together with its member countries and its Security Council, added to the participation of all the Organisms in the world that watch over the Peace and security of humanity, the citizens which is part of its inhabitants to exercise the right to control all the decisions of their rulers, The mass media, which together have the responsibility to call for calm and to inform with the best possible equanimity, because if a confrontation between the great powers breaks out, it will be too late to turn back.

In these times of uncertainty and at high risk of a terminal war, where we see with what euphoria the allies of the different parties involved are gathering together, preparing increasingly lethal armaments and mobilising ships with nuclear missile systems, making public threats from their own nations to set in motion the forbidden red button that will lead us to a nuclear disaster; we are already seeing how at every moment nations are joining a conflict that could be the end of human life in large territories, even on the whole earth.

Little is being heard in all spheres of looking for the peaceful dialogue that is so necessary to stop this mad rush to defeat the enemy by force of arms and with unpredictable consequences. Another way of conscience and calm is needed in these sad times of a war between Russia and Ukraine in the 21st century, aroused between twin peoples who are brothers in their history, as is the case with the conflict in Taiwan, which also adds to a possible confrontation between the greatest world powers, being well known that between all of these forces have the largest nuclear arsenals to wipe out all life on the face of the earth.

We already know the experiences of other wars and their subsequent consequences, with the experimental use of nuclear weapons, which left incalculable devastation that must never be repeated. We suffered a Holocaust in the West and a harmful nuclear climate with thousands of deaths in the East; in both cases with victims who could never return and affected by radioactivity for twenty generations.

That is why the nations that have been in past wars, the same ones that have lived through these painful and costly experiences, should be the first not to participate again in the same historical mistake, which should not be repeated out of memory and respect for so many victims; these nations should advise towards a prior peaceful dialogue, because post-war agreements in this confrontation, it is possible that they will never exist.

Today, weapons have an immediate terminal effect, a drama that is happening every day in the world, alarm that is frightening the population, which is involved in a nightmare, as a hostage, in which it is difficult to wake up. While it is very clear that the direct stakeholders of companies that sell arms and of the multinationals themselves are participating, when they are not the administrators of the population, since they were not elected by democratic decision.

It seems paradoxical that denouncing a crude truth such as this could be an attack on the markets, but statutory and moral coherence demands it to participants of the WOFP whose are committed to life and PEACE -with capital letters-; nevertheless, we apologise for our daring about although we consider it is our mission to provide early warning about.

However, the advisors to the leaders of the states in conflict and of the allied countries are responsible, as are other state advisors, who are the secret services with their intelligence teams that analyse the terrible results of a possible third world war.

Everyone sings when they go to war, but no one sings when they return.

A peaceful dialogue and a permanent cease-fire agreement is imminent, as a first mistake by a third party in discord or by the powers themselves, with such a powerful arsenal on active guard, can lead the entire world population to a path of no return.

We must all unite to save lives with the most committed solidarity ever, contributing to those affected by means of the advanced medicine already achieved in recent times, while this war must be stopped immediately.

Distinguished Sir, you are the one who knows the more, from your experience, that Peace is possible and the agreements are debatable; this is not a movie actor or puzzle players to see what happens, because it is not fiction and it is not a game either. There is reality in red alert, where at every moment unreturnable human lives are lost, nor is it a game for those who want to be honoured in history; since there will be no one who will be proud or aware of a modern history, if today's weapons are of mass destruction, very different from previous wars. All human beings of good will are surely aligned with a No to war and a Yes for Peace, so why not make use of the Yes, this proposal is for the general good, given that in this war we will all lose.

We are at the beginning of the third millennium, we know about good and evil, remembering a humanity that has always made the mistake of pitting man against man. We have grown up and everything is recorded in the chronicles of each of the times, so we are aware of the danger that the eight billion inhabitants are living, those who are still

struggling between life and death of a pandemic whose virus continues to mutate and its post virus sequels continue to damage human health, thus creating another risk with this ongoing war, which is aggravating so many other shortages and difficulties of the world's population.

The investments made in this war and other high costs programmed by the different nations directly and indirectly involved, could build thousands of much needed hospitals in nations without resources, those that are in oblivion, they are not betting on a war, they are only asking for help in the face of a virus that is still active.

There is no room for further tragedy, let alone escalation into such a dangerous world war. We must all join together to save lives with the most committed solidarity ever, contributing to those affected with the advanced medicine already achieved in recent times; And immediately, in parallel, to stop this warlike conflict.

World Organisation for Peace OMPP WOFP, humbly, together with all our Delegates, in their position of General Secretaries in 178 nations, commit ourselves to work from our spaces to favour this dialogue for the sake of a peaceful coexistence, for a future that belongs to all of us, we are here to serve.

Although we may be repetitive, peace is possible with the effort and good will of all of us. The roads of no return for an intelligent humanity are not passable, therefore without selfishness and with a clear vision we must think of the generations that will succeed us, they deserve a dignified and peaceful future: with a habitable, healthy and prosperous climate.

Mr. Secretary General of the United Nations, all the independent organizations and those who are part of your world institution, to which we consider ourselves loyal to respect your UN Charter of 1945 which was the pillar of the greatest creation of a mother Organization and regent of the future of our humanity which has been successful in stopping numerous wars; these are the foundations on which we must firmly stand.

We must firmly support it in these decisive moments to safeguard world peace and in the same way we trust that all UN member States will respect this guideline that marks the future of all, without excluding distinctions.
