His Excellency President of the Russian Federation Mr. Vladimir Putin

It is a great honor to address you, Mr. President, to thank you on behalf of our 178 Secretaries General in 178 nations, for your decision to participate in the Peace Dialogue with the President-Elect of the United States, who constantly repeats that he fully trusts that both will be able to end the war with Ukraine.

It is clear that this is the first time in this conflict that the opportunity for a Peace dialogue has presented itself, since as President-Elect Donald Trump emphasized, monologue will never achieve Peace. The world is mostly waiting for this mutual agreement that the new president of the United States supports and that you agree with, where it is the only way to return to that lasting Peace that is so necessary.

With you, Mr. President, we had the experience in the old millennium of receiving two messages of Peace that motivated different leaders to complete the book Messages of Peace for the New Millennium and you request to change it when you suffer an attack and add the danger of terrorism.

That book changed the thinking of many world leaders and you were the protagonist. That work of Peace is a tribute to the United Nations for its more than half century of work for World Peace. Today we are once again together with the Russian Federation and we fully trust that your gesture of good will can change history for the better.

We understood that in this war you have tried to protect the populations of both sides and history will be the one to tell the truth. We reiterate our thanks on behalf of the OMPP WOFP for your decision to seek an immediate solution and end this long conflict.

Your government team accompanied us in Geneva, Switzerland, in the treaty of the historic agreement, represented between Pope Francis of Argentina and Archbishop Kirill the Patriarch of all the Russias, representative of the Russian Orthodox Church, whom I greeted and all the archbishops who arrived in Geneva, and then we participated in that handshake and embrace in Havana, Cuba, between His Holiness Archbishop Kirill the Patriarch of all Russia and His Holiness Pope Francis of the Catholic Church, a place agreed by both to seal the meeting of brothers in the same Faith, suspended for a thousand years.

We greet you on behalf of the World Organization for Peace, with the highest respect and the greatest consideration.
